Wartime Evacuation and Propaganda

A day's suggested activities for schools visiting the South Devon Railway

1. Pupils and staff arrive at Totnes to catch the 11.30am steam train to the safety of rural Buckfastleigh. Our station is a 500m walk from Totnes National Rail station.

Many schools choose to have staff and pupils wear 1940s clothes, with the "evacuees" carrying a few possessions in a cardboard suitcase, their packed lunch (spam sandwiches, of course), an identification label and a gas mask.



2. The train journey to Buckfastleigh takes 30 minutes. There are some toilets on the train, and there is a buffet car for teachers and helpers! Pupils can write postcards home while on the journey.



SDR steam trains include coaches built by the Great Western Railway, so wartime evacuees could have travelled in them.

3. The train carrying the evacuees arrives at Buckfastleigh at 12.00 noon. Pupils and staff have the opportunity for a lunch and loo break – we have extensive facilities at our café, and there are more toilets on the station platform.

After lunch:

4. Dig for Victory: everything has to be grown – we can't get it from overseas any more.

Pupils use the station garden to see what crops are being grown, making compost, raising chickens and saving seed – and some good old rhubarb.



5. Meantime, there's a war on – and there may be casualties. Pupils see and use a military ambulance and a despatch rider's motor bike, as well as some of the 1940s medical



Pupils undertake the different activities in groups of up to 20, and rotate between them. The number of groups depends on the total number of pupils.

6. In the museum pupils see what happened on the railway during wartime, and learn about propaganda. Posters and newspapers of the time help illustrate the point.

7. Pupils board the 2.15pm train and their reserved seats for the journey back to Totnes and their waiting coach. Teachers and helpers can relax for the 30 minute journey with a cup of tea from the buffet car.
